Introduction

We care about the private life of our Website (« Website ») users (« User »). We commit in protecting the data the Users share with Us when using our Website. We commit in protecting and using their data in compliance with the applicable law.

This Privacy Policy describes our practices in collecting, using and disclosing the User's data via our Website when they access it on their device.

Before accessing or using our Website, please read carefully this Privacy Policy and make sure you fully understand our practices regarding your data. If you read and fully understand this Privacy Policy and are opposed to our practices, you are expected to stop using our Website immediately. By using our Website, you accept the conditions of this Privacy Policy and using our Website means that you accept it without any conditions.

The data we collect

Here are the type of data we may collect:

- Non identified and non identifiable data generated when registering or when using our Website (« non personal data »). This data does not allow us to identify the person involved. They are mainly technical data and aggregated data;
- Data providing direct or indirect individual identification (« personal data »), such as the name, email address, address, phone number, IP address or other details requested when necessary;
- If we combine both personal and non personal data, we may process the combined data as personal data as long as they will remain combined.

How do we collect the data?

Here are the main methods we are using to collect data:

- We collect and save data when Users are using our Website: use, sessions and related data;
- We collect voluntarily provided data such as contact details when contacting us via a contact form;
- We collect data from third parties such as Google.

Why do we collect the data?

We use your personal data for the following purpose:

- To provide and operate our Website;
- To develop, customise and improve our Website;
- To answer your reactions, enquiries and requests and assist you;
- To analyse the request and use pattern;
- To other internal, research or statistics purpose;
- To strengthen our data security and fraud prevention;
- To investigate potential violations, uphold our conditions or policies, or comply with the law, a regulation or an applicable governmental authority;
- To send updates, opinions, promotional documents and other information about our services. If we send you a promotional email, you can choose not to receive them anymore by clicking on the unsuscribing link in the end of the emails.

Whom do we share the data with?

We can share your data with service providers to operate our Website (eg. to host data with a third party provider).

We can also share your data for the following purpose:

- To investigate, detect or act on illegal activities or other reprehensible acts, suspected frauds or security matters;
- To establish or exercise our right of defence against legal claim;
- To protect our rights, our goods or our personal security and those of our Users or of the general public;
- If our company is the object of a change of control, including in case of a merge or acquisition;
- To collect, detain and/or manage your data via a third party provider (eg. online services) when reasonable for commercial purpose;
- To cooperate with third parties to improve your experience. To avoid any possible confusion, we can transfer, disclose your non personal data to third parties or use them in an other way at our sole discretion.

Cookies & similar technologies

When accessing or visiting our Website, we authorise third parties to use web tags, cookies, invisible pixels, scripts or other analysis technologies and services. Those can enable third parties to automatically collect data about you to improve your navigation on the Website and its performances, to personalise your experience, and for security and fraud prevention purposes.

We will not share your personal data with advertising online companies or advertising networks without your consent.

Where is the data stored?

Non personal data

Please note that our trusted service providers are located worldwide. Non personal data collected are stored and processed in different jurisdictions worldwide for purposes detailed in this Privacy Policy.

Personal data

Personal data may be stored and processed in the United States of America, Ireland, Japan and any other jurisdiction needed to our Website or if required by the law.

How long is the data stored?

Please note that we store data as long as is necessary to provide a fine Website and to comply with our legal or contract obligations, to handle a dispute and to uphold an agreements.

We can correct, complete or delete incomplete or inaccurate data at any time and at our sole discretion.

How does Wix protect the data?

The data hosting service provide the web platform or our Website. Your data can be hosted via hosting, database or general applications of our hosting provider. It hosts your data on secure servers behind a firewall and provide a secure HTTPS access to most of its services.

Minors

Our Website is not aimed at minors. We do not deliberately collect data about children. If you are minor, do not use our Website and do not provide us with any information.

We may require an evidence of your age at any time to make sure minors do not use our Website. We may forbid and deny access to any User under 18 and delete any stored data about this User. If you believe a minor shared information with us, please contact us.

Privacy

We will only use your personal data for purposes listed in this Privacy Policy, if the use of your personal data is needed:

- for a contract or for preparing a contract;
- to comply with a relevant legal or regulatory obligation;
- for our legitimate interest as a company, under the condition that this use is proportionate and respectful of your right to privacy at any time.

If you live in the EU, you can:

- Request the confirmation that personal data about you are processed or not and to access your stored personal data and some additional information;
- Request to receive the personal data you voluntarily provide us in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format;
- Request the correction of your personal data under our control;
- Request your personal data to be deleted;
- To oppose your personal data to be processed by us;
- Request your personal data process by us to be limited;
- File a complaint to the supervisory authority.

However, please not that those rights are not absolute and can be subjected to our own legitimate interest and regulatory requests. If you have general questions about the collected data or the way we use those data, please contact us.

For the purpose of providing our Website, we can forward data to trusted and secured service providers located worldwide. By using our Website, you agree to this forward of your data outside EEA.

CCPA compliance

If you are a Californian User using our Website, the Californian Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) can give you the right to request access to and removal of your data.
